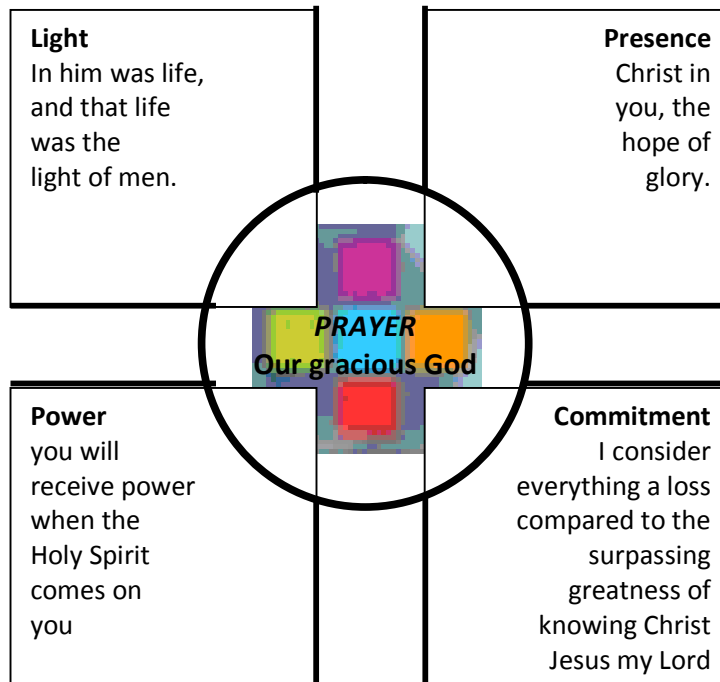


THE PARISH OF BETHERSDEN WITH HIGH HALDEN
